

Dr. Nikola Popović is an Assistant Research Professor at the Group for Probiotics and Microbiota-Host Interaction, Institute of Molecular Genetics and Genetic Engineering, University of Belgrade. He conducts scientific research on the role of novel natural probiotics and starter cultures in improving the quality and functionality of fermented products. Additionally, he studies the molecular mechanisms of action

of functional food in different model systems. Dr. Popović has co-authored 21 scientific papers, with 308 citations and an h-index of 10 (SCOPUS). He is also a reviewer for several international scientific journals and a member of the Serbian Society for Molecular Biology and the Serbian Society for Microbiology.
